DataFinder

The keystone of Oxford's Research data infrastructure

- Catalogue/Registry of research data by Oxford researchers
- Records only / minimum core metadata set
- Dissemination
- Discovery
- Citation
- Location
- Irrespective of format or discipline
- Compliance with funder requirements
- Reporting & business intelligence / CERIF
- Hierarchical model

Points of note

- Expected to be available from late Spring 2013
- Sustainability beyond project to be defined as part of Damaro project
- Need agreement to implement and manage policy for deposit of details of datasets into DataFinder



DataFinder

Requirements to reach full production quality

- The first release production service will be covered by a JISC funded project
- Further development will be required to implement additional features and functionality
- Staff will be required to run the service as part of the Bodleian Libraries' digital services
- Staff requirements are expected to include developer time (for continuing maintenance and metadata harvesting) and helpdesk within Bodleian Libraries
- Estimated a proportion of a software developer plus helpdesk staff
